March Outreach Highlights: A Month of Compassion and Celebration

Throughout March, our Nazareth Care communities demonstrated their commitment to meaningful outreach across South Africa. At Nazareth House Cape Town, we partnered with local schools for South African Library Week, hosting literacy activities for underserved youth while Lenten pancake feasts welcomed food-insecure neighbours. Nazareth House Durban engaged elderly from informal settlements through World Book Day storytelling and therapeutic wellness sessions, addressing both cultural and health needs. Nazareth House Port Elizabeth served over 1,200 meals through our Schauderville soup kitchen, while Human Rights Day art workshops empowered at-risk youth and Women's World Day of Prayer gatherings supported GBV survivors. Nazareth House Johannesburg extended skills development by training community caregivers in specialist hoist techniques and provided mentorship through youth programs, alongside pastry donations to homeless shelters. These initiatives reflect our proactive approach to addressing community needs through nutrition, education, skills transfer, and psychosocial support – building a more inclusive society through sustainable outreach.

Please join us in extending your heartfelt encouragement and best wishes to these deserving individuals. Their resilience and contributions continue to inspire us all.


